TOP FIXING INSTRUCTIONS



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR STANDARD TOP FIXING PANS – THIS TYPE OF PAN IS WHERE ONE HAS NO ACCESS TO THE FIXING BOLTS UNDERNEATH THE PAN AND CAN ONLY TIGHTEN AND FIX THE SEAT FROM THE TOP OF THE PAN.

 <p>Seat and cover</p> <p>A: Chrome Cover Plate B: Long through Bolt C: Hinge Plate D: Hinge Plate washer E: Expansion Bolt</p>	<h3>Component List</h3> <p>A. Chrome Cover Plate x 2 B. Long through Bolt x 2 C. Hinge Plate x 2 D. Hinge Plate washer x 2 E. Expansion Bolt x 2</p> <p>Tools Required </p>
	<h3>Step 1</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Fit component E (Expansion Bolt) into seat fixing holes on top of pan.2. Fit component D (Hinge Plate Washer) to underside of component C (Hinge Plate) and place over seat fixing hole (with expansion nut fitted) on top of the pan.3. Place component B (Long through bolt) through components C and D and into the holes of component E (Expansion Nut) and using a screwdriver, tighten until it is loosely secured to allow for adjustment of the seat on the pan.
	<h3>Step 2</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Adjust component C (the Hinge Plates) and then fit the seat onto component C (the Hinge Plates) With A Firm downward push..2. Adjust the seat to fit the pan front and back.3. With the seat now in the correct position use the screwdriver to tighten the threaded bar and fully secure the seat into the correct position
	<h3>Step 3</h3> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. After tightening lift seat into a not quite vertical position (75°) and lift off seat with a vertical pull.2. Fit item 1 (Chrome Cover Plates) over the tightened hinge plates securely.3. Fit the seat back onto hinge plate pegs and secure by pushing the seat down to engage fully. Your Family Seat is now fitted!
	<h3>Cleaning & Care Instructions</h3> <p>To remove your seat at any time for cleaning</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Lift your seat into a near vertical position and pull off. (See Step 3 above)2. After cleaning, place seat back on the seat hinge pegs and push to refit the seat fully.3. This seat is equipped with a slow close mechanism – DO NOT FORCE DOWN
<h3>CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS</h3> <p>Only use clean soapy water. The seat can be steam cleaned.</p> <p>Do not use abrasive cleaning products or products containing chlorine or acids, as these may cause yellowing or peeling of the material. Use ONLY a mild detergent/non-abrasive household cleaner or neutral soap or natural household cleaning products, which are best for effective, problem-free cleaning. Do not use bleach or any products containing bleach on the seat. Do not mix cleaning products as this can cause a reaction. After cleaning, ensure the chrome hinge is dried. Leave the seat and lid up whenever strong cleaning products (such as bleach) are left in the pan bowl to prevent damage to the seat from the vapours.</p>	









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BOTTOM FIXING INSTRUCTIONS



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR STANDARD BOTTOM FIXING PANS – WHERE ONE TIGHTENS THE SEAT FROM THE UNDERSIDE OF THE PAN.

<p>Component List</p> <p>A. Chrome Cover Plate x 2 B. Long through Bolt x 2 C. Hinge Plate x 2 D. Hinge Plate washer x 2 E. Rubber coated Washer x 2 F. Tightening Wing-Nut x 2</p> <p>Tools Required </p>	 <p>Seat and cover</p>
<p>Step 1</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Fit component D (Hinge Plate Washer) to underside of component C (Hinge Plate).2. Place component C (Hinge Plates) over seat fixing holes on top of the pan.3. Insert component B (long bolt) through components C & D and into the pan seat fixing holes.4. Slide component E (Rubber Coated Washer) on to component B (Long Bolt) and ensure the metal part of component E (Rubber coated Washer) is facing downwards.5. Thread on component F (Wing-Nut) on to component B (Long Bolt) and tighten until it is finger tight only.	
<p>Step 2</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Adjust component C (the Hinge Plates) and then fit the seat on to component C (the Hinge Plates) and push down to engage2. Adjust the seat to fit the pan front and back.3. With the seat now in the correct position, insert a screwdriver on to the bolt head to assist fully tightening component F (Wing-Nuts) and fully tighten component C (Hinge Plates) fixing seat into position.	
<p>Step 3</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. After tightening lift seat into a not quite vertical position (75°) and lift off seat with a vertical pull.2. Fit item 1 (Chrome Cover Plates) over the tightened hinge plates securely.3. Fit the seat back onto hinge plate pegs and secure by pushing the seat down to engage fully. Your Family Seat is now fitted!
